Course Description	<p>This course is designed for students who wish to work within the agriculture industry on farms, with crops and/or stock, performing general farm maintenance tasks. Assorted practical workshops and theory training sessions will consist of workshops covering Work, Health and Safety; Environmental work practices; Chemical accreditation; Welding and workshop tools; Livestock feeding plans; Machinery maintenance; Crop agronomy; Chainsaw use and maintenance; Working at heights and working in confined spaces; and Senior first aid. The students may also have an opportunity to gain ticket/s for various mobile plant eg Front End Loader. Most of the training to complete this course will be covered in the workshops. However in addition to the workshops, there is a requirement for the students to complete some records of the training they receive as part of their work placement. These Skills Development Records will be selected on an individual basis to correspond as closely as possible with their tasks completed 'on the job'.</p>
