Theoretical work will be completed in sessions at Oakbank Area School with practical work occurring at Oakbank Area School, local Pastoral Properties and Monarto Zoo. Practical workshops involve working with domestic animals, wildlife and livestock.</p> <p>Information provided about this course may be subject to change.</p>
