Course Length	2 semesters (1 year)																		
Course Description	Students who graduate from the D2C course and wish to further their construction skills in carpentry areas can apply for the D2C+ (carpentry) Program. Students will undertake units of competency from Certificate III in Construction (carpentry). Successful completion of this D2C+ program may reduce the length of an apprenticeship by one to two years, to be negotiated with the Registered Training Organisation and future employer. Students are required to participate in structured workplace learning in industry.																		
Pathways	This course leads to Certificate III courses in a range of different trade areas as well as School Based Apprenticeships and full Apprenticeships.																		
Entry Requirements	Students applying for this course must have successfully completed the D2C Certificate I in Construction program (or equivalent).																		
Other Requirements	The Personal Protective clothing and Equipment provided in 2019 must be re-used in 2020. Doorways shirts must be worn and visible at all times while on site.																		
Delivery Location(s)	Building & Construction Centre, Heathfield High School, 99 Longwood Road, Heathfield, SA, 5153 If students are driving to the course they must park in the Mt Lofty Community Sports Centre car park (Gate 4). No vehicles are to be driven onto school grounds.
