

## Course Details - CPC30211 Certificate III in Carpentry (Heathfield High School)

Course Length	2 semesters (1 year)
Course Description	Students who graduate from the Construction Pathways course and wish to further their construction skills in carpentry areas can apply for the D2C+ (carpentry) program. Students will undertake units of competency from Certificate III in Construction (carpentry). Successful completion of this D2C+ program may reduce the length of an apprenticeship by one to two years, to be negotiated with the Registered Training Organisation and future employer. Students are required to participate in structured workplace learning in industry.
Pathways	This course leads to Certificate III courses in a range of different trade areas as well as School Based Apprenticeships and full Apprenticeships.
Entry Requirements	Students applying for this course must have successfully completed the Certificate II in Construction Pathways program (or equivalent).
Other Requirements	The Personal Protective clothing and Equipment provided in 2020 must be re-used in 2021. Doorways shirts must be worn and visible at all times while on site.
