It also offers a pathway to further study in many areas including Disability Services, Leisure and Health, Enrolled and Registered Nursing. Delivery of this qualification includes formal study at TAFESA and a Structured Work Placement in a relevant setting. Information provided about this course may be subject to change.

Entry Requirements	Must have a strong interest in Aged Care and a moderate level of Literacy and Numeracy		
Other Requirements	All 3 certificates must be obtained prior to starting the course: 1. A DSCI clearance is required by ALL students prior to starting the course. Students must apply through their home school for this clearance. Cost is \$55.00 payable to your home school. 2. A Police clearance is required and must be applied for prior to starting the course through the local police station. This is an additional cost. 3. A National Crime Check must be applied for prior to starting the course. This is an additional cost of \$48.00.
